
## **Subject: Pre-Framed Art**

In addition to our customary framing services, the Parkville Frame Gallery has been expanding our offering of "pre-framed" fine art reproductions. We understand that in today's busy world you may not have the time to research available art, and the various nuances of today's sophisticated printing methods, types of substrates, glazing techniques, frame types and styles, etc. Therefore, we have purchased a variety of very high-quality, museum-grade fine art reproductions in varying styles and sizes. We have pre-framed those reproductions in the gallery with what we consider to be the most appropriate framing materials and methods. The pre-framed reproductions are being offered as ready-to-hang, "finished products". However, we anticipate that you might want a different style or size of framed reproduction. If that proves to be the case we can work together with you to accommodate your ideas.



We encourage you to stop by the gallery and view the growing number of ready-to-hang art reproductions and sculpture that we currently have on display. For example, we are currently displaying a print of the painting *Cleopatra*. British artist John William Waterhouse completed this very popular painting in 1887. Another print that is on display in the gallery is the religious-theme painting *Salvatore Mundi* (ca.1500), which is thought to have been painted by Italian artist Leonardo di ser Piero da Vinci (1452--1519).

We are also offering pre-framed reproductions from our **American History Series**. The reproductions in this series include paintings of *George Washington*, *Thomas Jefferson*, President *Lincoln*, as well as other American patriots. Along with our pre-framed pictures we will provide a free, printed description of the art work. We will attach that description to the back of the print in an unsealed plastic sleeve. Having that information available will enable you to refer to the history of the art, and the artist, anytime you desire. In addition, the sleeve will provide you with a convenient place to keep any documents associated with your purchase (e.g., sales receipts, etc.).
